- ★ India has 1382 off-shore islands: 1093 shapes (Islands) and 289 Points (Rocks/Rocky Islets)
- ★ Rich unexplored resource; potential still untapped
- ★ Five inter-ministerial groups formed: Shortlisted 20 islands
- ★ Collected data for over 35 attributes of these islands
  - Engaged international experts to prepare a detailed development plan

## | SIMPLIFICATION OF LAWS |

Total number of state laws in Rajasthan:

**592 (405 principal acts and 187 amending acts)**

**61 principal acts and 187 amending acts repealed by October 2015.**

**Eight ordinances, retained since 1949, too, were scrapped**

Target:

**By September 2016, trimming the number of statutes to just 277**

**In next phase: The 277 statutes will be down to 150**

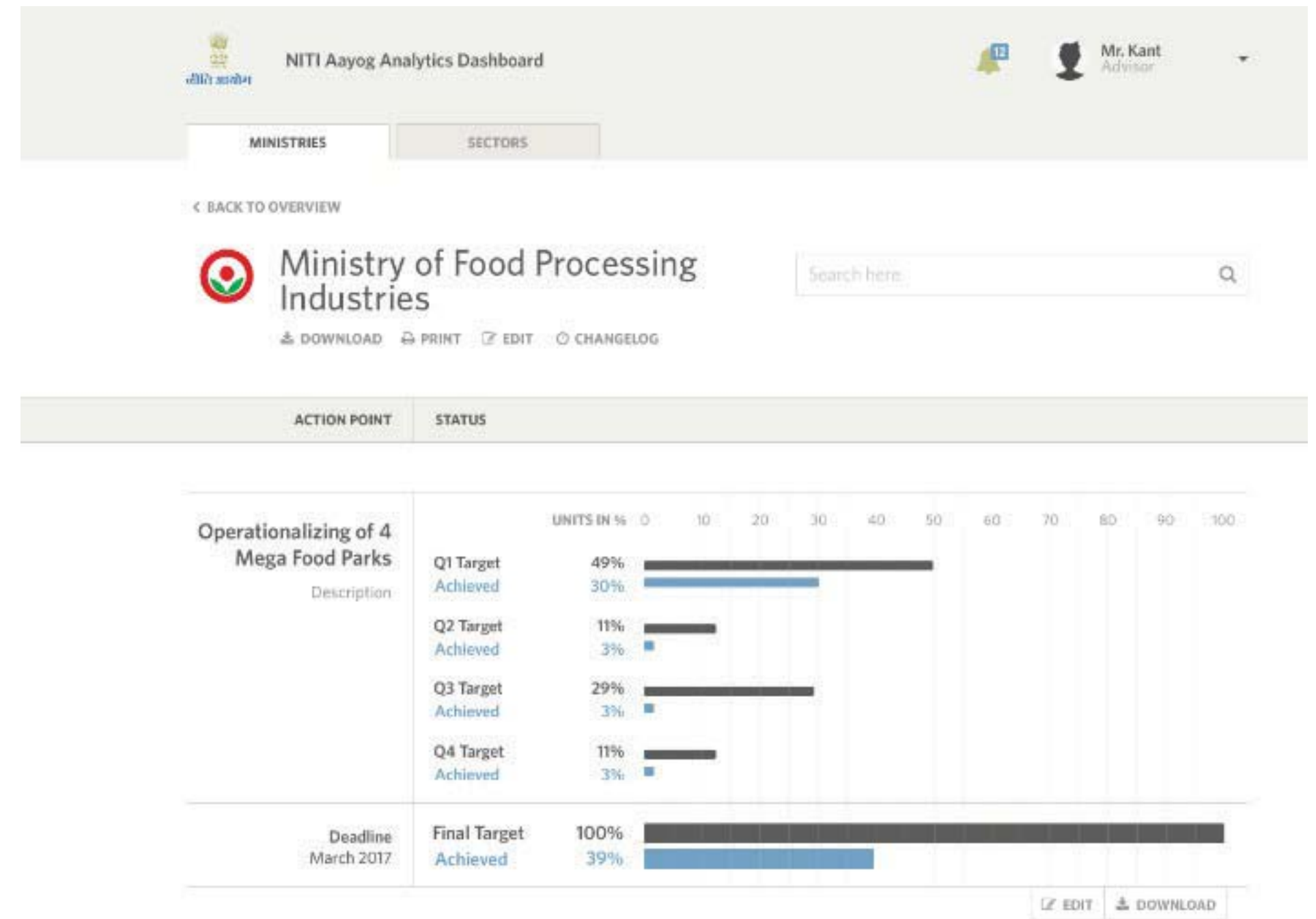

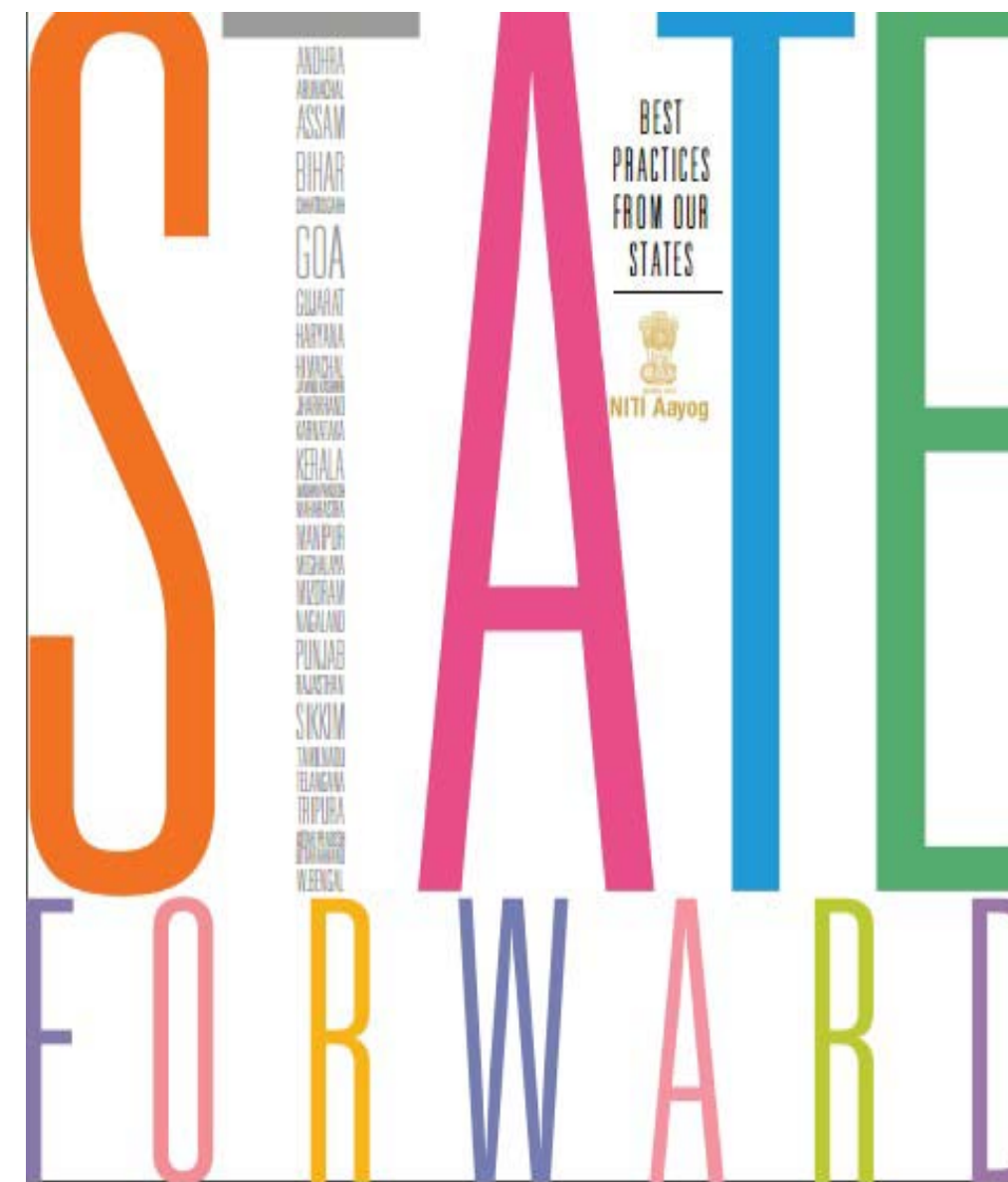
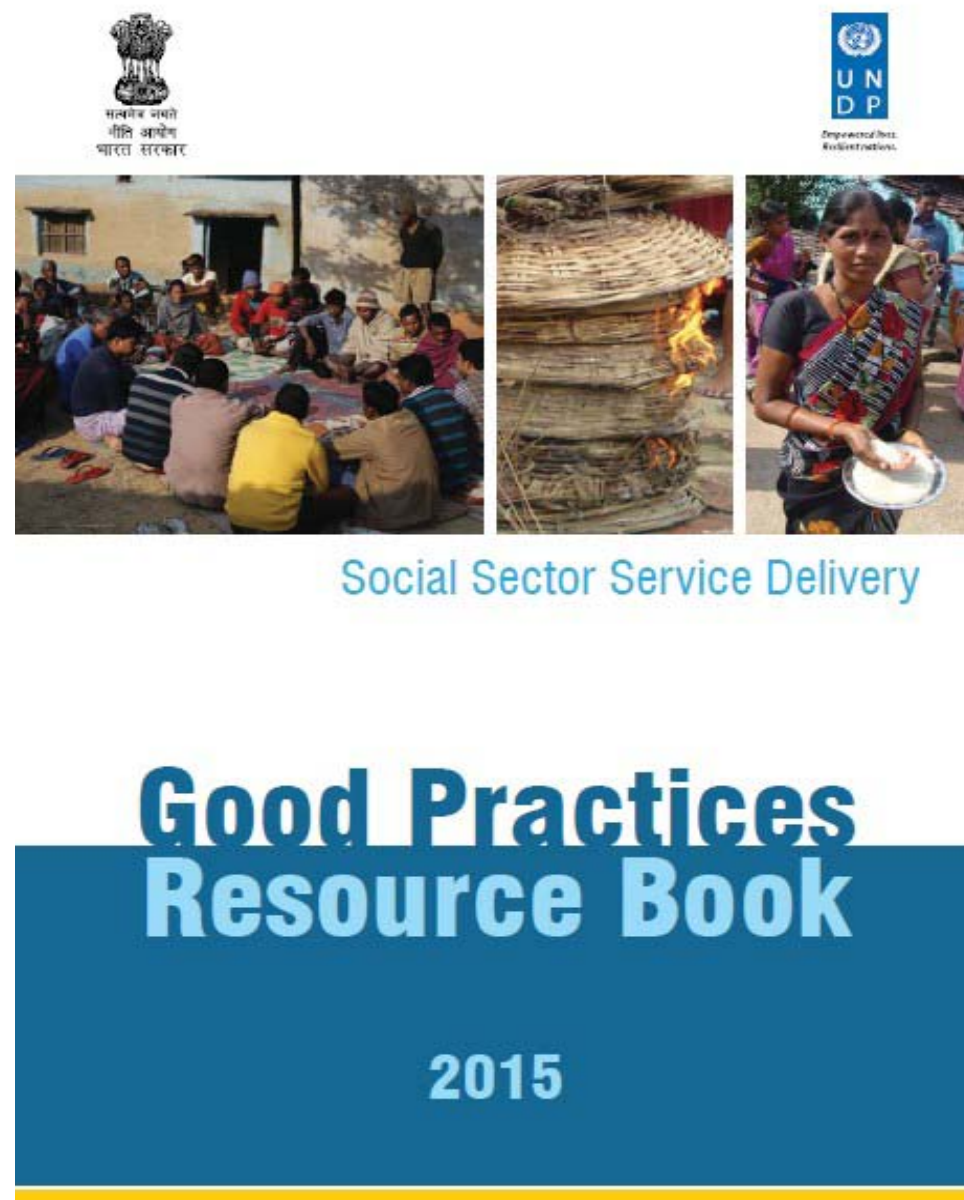
