# 1. Highlights

1. An extensive Civil Society-Consultation (CSC) to provide inputs for the Approach Paper to the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan was held involving large number of CSOs, as highlighted in the Approach Paper as well as in the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan Document.

2. Voluntary Action Cell has held extensive discussions with those who were reportedly actively involved in the process, namely, two Members of the Planning Commission; Principal Adviser, a couple of Advisers and a few other officials of the Planning Commission; Chairperson, Statistical Commission of India & the then Principal Adviser (PCMD), Planning Commission and also with some key 'external' stakeholders.

3. This report is an attempt to reconstruct the entire CSC process that was held under the aegis of the erstwhile Planning Commission as record for reference if any in future. The Report has been prepared After consulting several 'external' and 'internal' stakeholders who were involved in the "**Civil Society (CS) - Consultation Process**". Salient features of the consultation process are:

- i. A list of 1,149 CS representatives who participated in the process prepared on the basis of on the inputs from human rights activists and social action groups *Wada Na Todo Abhiyan (WNTA)*, Arghyam, and National Campaign on Dalit Human Rights (NCDHR) is at Annexure - IV.
- ii. Twelve core challenges were identified by the Planning Commission, based on 340 cell matrix discussed and documented by officers of the Commission. These challenges were discussed with the CS representatives to utilize their in-depth knowledge on the development issues.
- iii. *WNTA*, the lead NGO in this process, organized 15 consultations across the country during Sept-Dec 2010 to discuss the 12 identified challenges.

- iv. Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission, Members and some officials reportedly participated in different consultative meetings.
- v. WNTA, with support from United Nation Development Program (UNDP), submitted a report '**Approaching Equity: Civil Society Inputs for the Approach Paper - 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan**'

- vii. After release of the draft Approach Paper for the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan, WNTA produced another publication '**Equity Unaddressed – A Civil Society Response to the Draft Approach Paper 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan**'
- viii. - ix. Before the above-referred exercise, CSOs were also engaged actively in the Mid Term Appraisal of the 11<sup>th</sup> FY Plan and came out with a People's Mid Term Appraisal (PMTA) and produced two reports: **i) Voices of the People** and **ii) A Review of Selected Sectors** under the broad head '**How inclusive is the Eleventh Five Year Plan**. These reports are also available on the UNDP website.
- x. In order to maintain the autonomy of their inputs as well for bureaucratic ease, WNTA decided to approach organizations other than Planning Commission as there were fears that the Commission funding would usurp the autonomy of inputs and the freedom to critique.
- xi. The Approach Paper for the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan was approved in October 2011 followed by approval of 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan Document by NDC in December 2012. Many inputs / suggestions from the CS-Consultations were referred to and

taken into consideration by Subject Matter Divisions, while finalizing the Approach Paper as well as the respective chapters of 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan Document.

- xii. An important suggestion of the CSC process was for the Planning Commission to proactively engage the CSO networks to elicit grassroots inputs for the upcoming Mid Term Appraisal of the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan and institutionalize the process.

## 2. Background

1. The rationale behind undertaking the civil society consultation, as provided in the 'Scenario: Shaping India's Future' is given below:

The cabinet resolution of March 15, 1950 setting up the Indian Planning Commission says, **"The work of the Planning Commission will affect decisively the future welfare of the people** in every sphere of national life. Its **success will depend on the extent to which it enlists the association and cooperation of people at all levels.**"

**Planning in India was required to be a participative process, with inputs from the people, and benefits for the people. However, each five-year plan seemed to drift further and further away from the language and concerns of people into the realms of economic numbers and financial budgets. Therefore, it has become necessary to adjust the method of planning, to connect planners more strongly with people. Even if the founding fathers of India's planning had not intended it in the 1950s - though they clearly did – the ubiquity of means of communication with citizens in the 21<sup>st</sup> century along with the strength of belief in the rights of citizens to actively participate in their own governance, would have required India's planning process to change to enable more participation by citizens.**

2. The development of the Approach to the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan commenced with an integrative reflection, by all the divisions of the Planning Commission cutting across their organizational and disciplinary boundaries, about the fundamental challenges facing the country - challenges that cut across sectors and regions. One such challenge, flowing from Sectors of Health, Education and Labour is the condition of 'markets' in these sectors with respect to their equity, not merely their efficiency. Another challenge is the "democratization of information" across sectors and regions of the country. And another is the quality of "decentralized governance".

3. In devising an appropriate structural framework for the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan, the Planning Commission sought to assess sector specific challenges

(Health, Education, Agriculture etc.) as well as well as systemic challenges (deep deep-rooted and often invisible issues which manifest into visible problems). The Commission started out with 34 considerations, which were assessed from ten points of view is: 1) citizen's expectations, 2) governance and institutions, 3) markets, 4) global developments, 5) skills and demography, 6) science and technology, 7) information, 8) land, climate, and environment, 9) innovation and enterprise, and 10) financing the plan. This exercise enabled the Commission to gain a comprehensive view of the many facets of each of the 34 issues. The resulting 340 cell matrix was discussed and documented in detail by officers of the Commission during a three day retreat in October 2010, at the end of which , 12 core challenges (6 sectoral and 6 systemic) were identified, which are:

### **I. Enhancing capacity for growth**

Today, India can sustain a GDP growth of 8 percent a year. Increasing this to 9 to 10 percent will need more mobilization of investment resources; better allocation of these resources through more efficient capital markets; more efficient use of resources through the public system; and , higher investment in infrastructure through both public and Public-Private Partnership routes.

### **II. Enhancing skills and faster generation of employment**

It is believed that India' economic growth is not generating enough jobs or livelihood opportunities. At the same time, many sectors face manpower shortages. To address both, we need to improve our education and training systems; create efficient and accessible labor markets for all skill categories; and encourage the faster growth of small and micro enterprises.

### **III. Managing the environment**

Environmental and ecological degradation has serious global and local implications, especially for the most vulnerable citizens of our country. How can we encourage responsible behavior, without compromising on our development needs?

### **IV. Markets for efficiency and inclusion**

Open, integrated, and well-regulated markets for land, labor, capital, as well as for goods and services are essential for growth, inclusion, and sustainability. We have many sectors where markets are non-existent

or incomplete, especially those which are dominated by public provisioning. How do we create or improve markets in all sectors?

#### **V. Decentralization, Empowerment and Information**

Greater and more informed participation of all citizens in decision-making, enforcing accountability, exercising their rights and entitlements; and determining the course of their lives is central to faster growth, inclusion, and sustainability. How can we best promote the capabilities of all Indians, especially the most disadvantaged, to achieve this end?

#### **VI. Technology and Innovation**

Technological and organizational innovation is the key to higher productivity and competitiveness. How can we encourage and incentivize innovation and their diffusion in academia and government as well as in enterprises of all sizes?

#### **VII. Securing the energy future for India**

Faster and more inclusive growth will require a rapid increase in energy consumption. Since we have limited domestic resources, how can we meet this need equitably and affordably without compromising on our environment?

#### **VIII. Accelerated development of transport infrastructure**

Our inadequate transport infrastructure result in lower efficiency and productivity; higher transaction costs; and insufficient access to our large national market. How can we create an efficient and widespread multi-modal transport network?

#### **IX. Rural Transformation and Sustained Growth of Agriculture**

Rural India suffers from poor infrastructure and inadequate amenities. Low agricultural growth perpetuates food and nutritional insecurities, which also reduces rural incomes. How can we encourage and support our villages in improving their living and livelihood conditions in innovative ways?

#### **X. Managing Urbanization**

Most of our metros and cities are under severe stress with inadequate social and physical infrastructure coupled with worsening pollution. Migration pressures are likely to increase. How do we make our cities more livable? What can we do today to ensure that smaller cities and towns are not similarly overwhelmed tomorrow?



## **XI. Improved access to Quality Education**

Educational and training facilities have been increasing rapidly. However, access, affordability, and quality remain serious concerns. Employability is also an issue. How can we improve the quality and the utility of our education, while ensuring equity and affordability?

## **XII. Better preventive and curative healthcare**

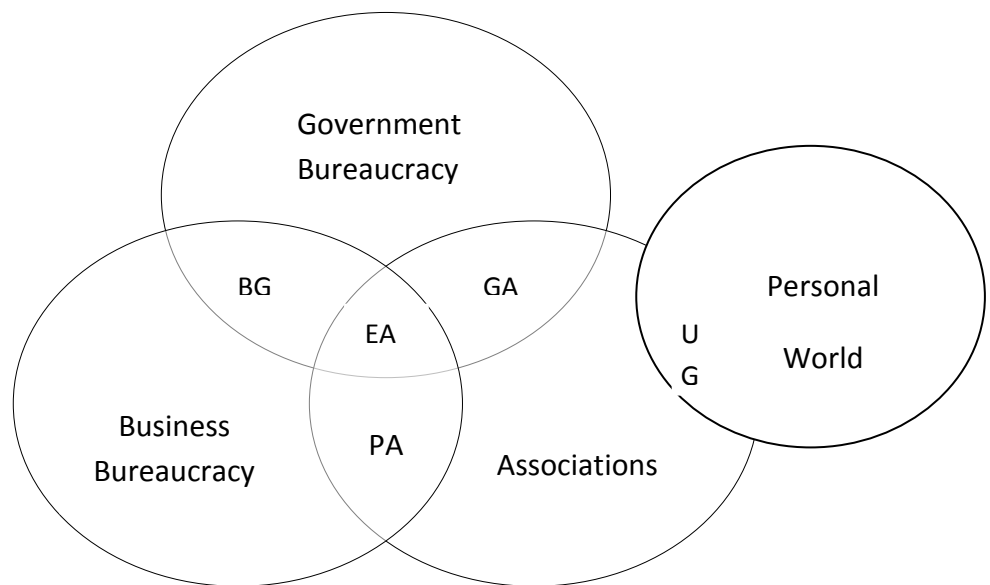
India's health indicators are not improving as fast as other socio-economic indicators. Good healthcare is perceived to be either unavailable or unaffordable. How can we improve healthcare conditions, both curative and preventive, especially relating to women and children?

### 3. The Worlds of the Voluntary Sector

1. Billis (1989) explained that in order to understand voluntary sector it is necessary to distinguish three different 'worlds', each with its own 'rules of the game'. These three worlds, shown diagrammatically (Figure below), are: a) The Personal, b) The Associational and c) The Bureaucratic (which is further divided into the governmental and profit-seeking bureaucracies).

2. All the three worlds, shown above under the theory of Billis, overlap and the overlapping areas form the 'ambiguous zones'. This model, explains the ambiguity of voluntary sector. Thus, the ambiguous zones of voluntary sector are GA, PA and EA because of the overlaps and interactions of the three worlds of voluntary sector. Billis (1989:25) suggests that understanding of such worlds and zones is necessary for 'genuine management of the complexity' or ambiguity of the voluntary sector, among its other utilities.

3. Four models of GO-NGO relationships have been proposed by Gidron et al. (1992:16-20). These models are as follows:

#### **I. Government-Dominant Model**

Here, government plays dominant role in both the financing and delivery of human services, using the tax system to raise funds for, and government employees to deliver, needed services.

#### **II. Third-Sector-Dominant Model**

At the opposite extreme is the situation in which NGOs play the dominant role in both the financing and delivery of services. This model typically prevails where opposition to government involvement in social welfare provision is strong either for ideological or sectarian reasons, or where the need for such services has not yet been widely accepted.

#### **III. Dual Model**

In between these two extreme models, in which the financing and delivery of human services are in some sense shared between government and the civil sector, albeit in significantly different configurations. This can take two forms. First, non-profits can *supplement* the services provided by the state, delivering the same kinds of services but to clients not reached by the state. Alternatively, the nonprofit sector can *complement* the offerings of government by filling needs not met by government activities. In either case the distinguishing feature is the existence of two sizeable, but relatively autonomous, systems of service, finance and delivery.

#### **IV. Collaborative Model**

This shared pattern also features significant action by both government and the nonprofit sector, but here they work together rather than separately. Typically this takes the form of government providing the finance and the NGOs actually delivering the services, but the opposite is also theoretically possible. Important differences can exist in the nature of the sharing that occurs, depending on the extent of discretion that the service provider retains in the bargain. On the one hand, non-profits can simply function as agents of government programme administrators, with little discretion or bargaining power. This might be termed as the *collaborative-vendor* model. Alternatively, third-sector organisations can retain a considerable amount of discretion, either in managing programmes or, through the political process, in developing them. Such a situation might be termed a *collaborative-partnership* model.



## 4. The CS-Consultation Process

1. To document the process of civil society consultation (CS – Consultation) organized for drafting the Approach Paper for the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan (2012-17), discussions were held with those who were reportedly actively involved in the process, namely, two Members of the Planning Commission, Principal Adviser, a couple of Advisers and a few other officials of the Planning Commission, Chairperson, Statistical Commission of India & the then Principal Adviser (PCMD), Planning Commission and also with other key external stakeholders.

2. We are sincerely thankful to these officials and non-officials for providing their valuable inputs, without which the reconstruction of CS-Consultation process perhaps would not have been possible. List of Officials/Non-Officials of Planning Commission and External stakeholders consulted for reconstructing the process of CS-Consultation is placed at Annex I. A flow-chart on the process and chronology of events are at (Annex-II) and (Annex-III) respectively.

3. Based on the information collected from Wada Na Todo Abhiyan (WNTA) National Campaign on Dalit Human Rights (NCDHR) and Arghyam; a list of 1,149 CS representatives has been compiled. Civil Society (CS) generally constitutes the space occupied by various stakeholders between the state and the market. Thus, those consulted include broadly the ones belonging to the Voluntary Sector, Academia, think tanks, News channels, News-paper houses, Cooperatives, Trade Unions, Welfare Associations, and Civil Society also including citizens working in various CSOs/NGOs, international organizations, Panchayats or acting in their personal capacities.

4. Therefore, it may be surmised that the cited figure of 950/900 CSOs in the Approach Paper as well as in the Plan Document for the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan appears to be an approximate indicative number. The list of 1,149 CS representatives compiled here and placed at Annex IV is also not exhaustive. However, now reasonably extensive database on the CS representatives who participated in the consultative process prior to the formulation of the Approach Paper to the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan is available.

5. As per a report by the World Economic Forum/ KPMG, ten roles are being performed by the CSOs / NGOs now-a-days and these roles are:

- i. **Watchdog:** holding institutions to account & promoting transparency
- ii. **Advocate:** raising awareness of societal issues & challenges
- iii. **Expert:** bringing unique knowledge & experience to shape policy
- iv. **Capacity builder:** providing education and training
- v. **Incubator:** developing solutions that may require a long gestation
- vi. **Representative:** giving power to the voice of the marginalized
- vii. **Citizenship champion:** encouraging citizen engagement
- viii. **Solidarity supporter:** promoting fundamental and universal values
- ix. **Definer of standards:** creating norms that shape market & state activity
- x. **Service provider:** delivering services to meet societal needs such as education, health, food & security.

6. These roles may not be distinctly different and may be overlapping. Majority of the CSOs who participated in the CS-Consultation process appear to belong to the aforesaid first nine categories, having members from the clan of advocates, watchdogs, experts, capacity builders, citizenship champions. Besides those who have signed-up on the NGO-PS portal largely belong to the last referred category of 'Service providers'. The general perception of most of the grant-giving government departments about NGOs/CSOs is that they are 'Service provider' organizations, since interaction with other type of CSOs is relatively limited.

## **Twelve Identified challenges and CS-Consultation Process**

7. The examination of identified 12 challenges for the country and suggestions for how they should be managed was carried out by a widely participative process, perhaps the most participative planning process the Planning Commission has ever conducted. About 1,000 civil society organizations, representing all sections of society, especially those who have not felt sufficiently included so far in India's plans and growth, came together on a common platform of their own, *Wada Na Todo Abhiyan*. They reached back into their member bases to discuss the systemic challenges identified by the Planning Commission and then they provided their views to the Planning Commission.

8. Reportedly, apart from Planning Commission Deputy Chairman Shri Montek Singh Ahluwalia, Members – Shri Arun Maira, Dr. Syeda Hameed, Shri Mihir Shah and Professor Abhijit Sen, along with the then Principal Adviser to the Commission Dr. Pronab Sen played crucial roles in the initiative. Other Members of the Planning Commission, viz. Dr K. Kasturirangan, Shri B. K. Chaturvedi, Shri Saumitra Chaudhuri and Professor Narendra Jadhav also reportedly participated in some of the consultative meetings organized by WNTA.

9. It is for the first time that the Planning Commission opened its doors for engaging with various stakeholders at the stage of preparing the Approach Paper for the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan. Equally creditable are the efforts made by the members of the civil society groups in assimilating the wide ranging inputs through 15 regional consultations divided among diverse constituencies and binding them together in the civil society draft titled "Approaching Equity" for Approach paper. Particularly significant, in this direction, has been the role of Wada Na Todo Abhiyan (WNTA) along with key players such as CBGA, NACDOR and others in leading and steering the entire exercise.



10. The 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan has been far more progressive as it had been a striking step towards allowing people's participation at the very stage of plan formulation. This time the consultation was to "precede rather than follow" the plan document. Ideologically, it established/prepared grounds for a substantial democratic decentralized phenomenon. Although the agenda of an inclusive growth was adopted in the EFYP itself, it was with the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan formulation process that the term inclusiveness was used in the practical/literal sense. The 12<sup>th</sup> Plan, as of now is likely to have something unique and progressive to offer, especially in transforming norms of formulation and the processes employed. The change has been established through -

- i. Opening up of the Planning Commission – to civil society inputs and direct people's participation through online inputs
- ii. Participation by a wide network of Civil Society Organizations - in the process of plan formulation in a more progressive manner.

11. The two-way initiative on the part of the Planning Commission and the CSOs has opened up windows of participation at the initial stage of formulating the Approach Paper. The significance of the Approach Paper to a plan lies in the fact that it is more or less a comprehensive reflection of the final plan document. It lays out the strategic framework which



guides the preparation of the prospective Five Year Plan. It builds upon the Mid Term Appraisal, which is a critical review of the successes and failures of the previous Five Year Plan. A key function of the Approach Paper is to identify pressing issues and systemic failures, and suggest a range of alternatives to address them. In specific terms, the Approach paper lays out the broad strategy and options; not schemes or specific interventions. In laying out this strategy, a political mandate is sought for the stated objectives and targets, and the broad policy measures necessary to achieve them. These directions contained in the Approach Paper are elaborated in the Five Year Plan in terms of specific policies, programmes, and schemes.

12. Before the above-referred exercise, CSOs were also engaged actively by WNTA in the Mid Term Appraisal of the 11<sup>th</sup> FY Plan and came out with a People's Mid Term Appraisal (PMTA) and produced two reports: i) Voices of the People and ii) A Review of Selected Sectors under the broad head 'How inclusive is the Eleventh Five Year Plan. These reports are also available on the UNDP website.



13. Realizing the importance of the Approach Paper, WNTA grabbed the opportunity of engaging with the plan process at the stage of formulation of the Approach Paper.

14. WNTA was the lead anchor owing to its wide network and facilitator of the process. The Planning Commission had asked civil society groups to hold 15 consultations and one thematic presentation on decentralization across India on various social issues and issues relating to marginalized groups.



15. A publication prepared by the WNTA, with support from UNDP, 'Equity Unaddressed - A Civil Society Response to the Draft Approach Paper 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan' and also available at: [[http://www.undp.org/content/dam/india/docs/equity\\_unaddressed\\_a\\_civil\\_society\\_response\\_to\\_the\\_draft\\_approach\\_paper\\_12th\\_five\\_year\\_plan.pdf](http://www.undp.org/content/dam/india/docs/equity_unaddressed_a_civil_society_response_to_the_draft_approach_paper_12th_five_year_plan.pdf)] mentions that all the CSO groups, involved in the CS-Consultation, rejected GDP growth alone as a goal of planning. Instead they suggested:

- i. Creating a comprehensive real-time database on the marginalization of and violence against the poor and vulnerable to enable more realistic and just planning;
- ii. Provision of access to essential entitlements and development opportunities to the marginalized by increasing investment in public services;
- iii. Ensuring transparency and accountability mechanisms for people's participation in monitoring public services;
- iv. Upholding laws against exploitation, such as labour laws and protection laws for vulnerable groups, especially in situations of conflict;
- v. Defending justice for those affected by displacement and environmental damage;
- vi. Supporting migrants' rights and entitlements, both internally and internationally;
- vii. Developing sustainable agriculture policy to address agricultural distress along with appropriate plans for post-production and marketing;
- viii. Enabling truly inclusive local governance; and
- ix. Promoting renewable non-conventional energy solutions.

16. For the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan engagement, WNTA did not ask for financial assistance from the Planning Commission to avoid the charge of co-optation by the state. With the same thinking, some of the CS networks try to avoid government funding, discard the conditionalities attached to the grants and carry on the job of uniting diverse grassroots elements in a common political struggle to transform the state. In this document WNTA pledges to carry on their engagement with Policy Planners during the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan and even beyond in the following words:

“The 12<sup>th</sup> Plan must emerge from a framework that is livelihood-based, people-centric, pro-poor, and owned by the people themselves, as these are the foundations of truly inclusive and sustainable development. This engagement with the 12<sup>th</sup> FY Plan, which began with the inputs for the Approach Paper, forms part of our larger commitment to the planning process in India. **We shall continue to proactively engage with policy makers and CSOs through different processes such as consultations, workshops and micro-level planning at all points from the national and state to district and community levels during the development and implementation of the 12<sup>th</sup> Plan and even beyond**”.

## **The Way Forward**

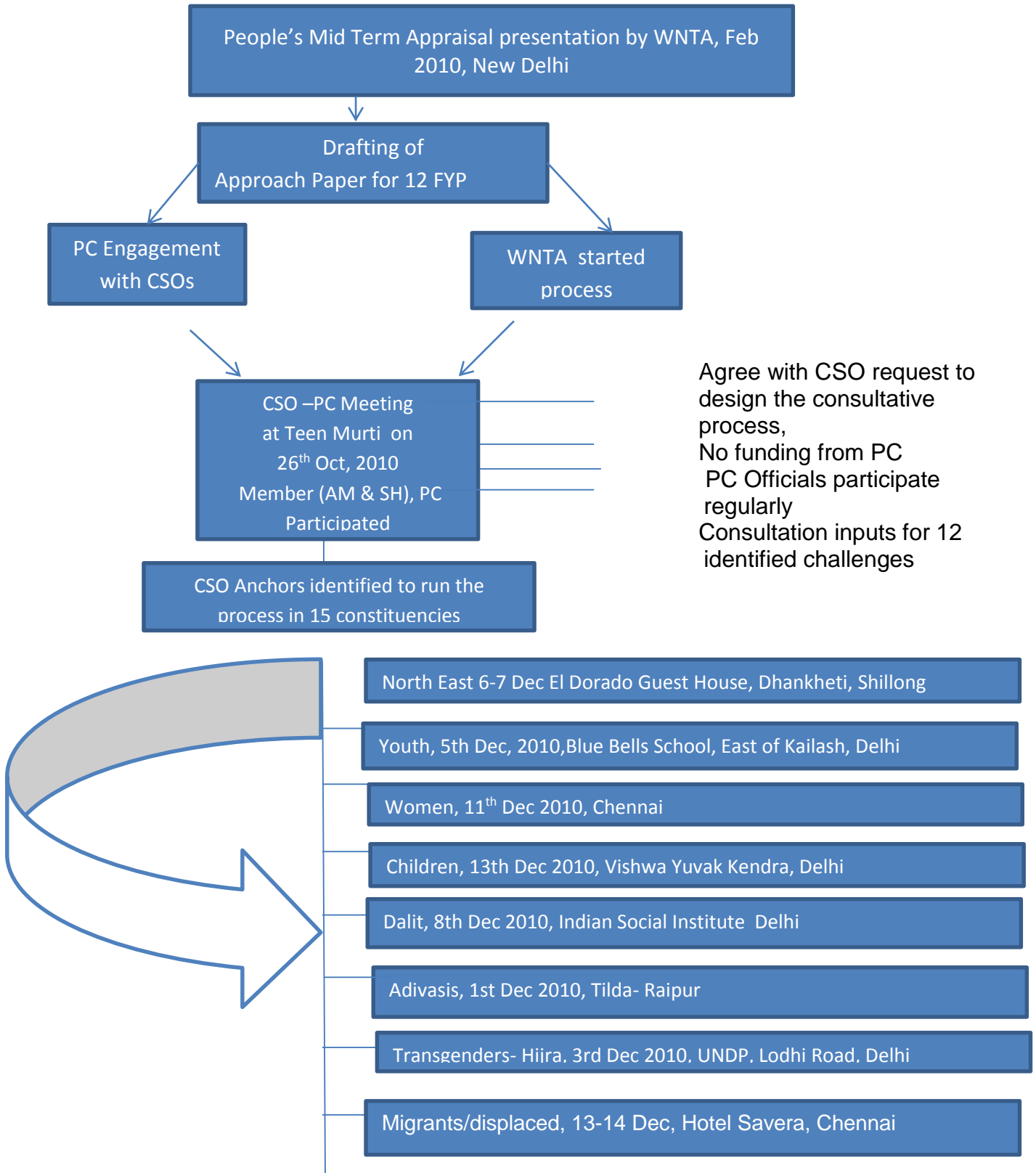
1. Documentation of the CS-Consultation or engagement with the 'external' stakeholders as narrated above is placed for record and future reference.
2. Institutionalize the CS-Consultation process and involve CSOs in future planning/ mid-term appraisal.
3. In formulation of Social Sector Legislation concerning Health, Surrogacy Adoption and Women's issues etc. the CS-Consultation Process may be useful and the respective Ministries should adopt the same for analization of such draft Legislations.
4. CS-Consultation Process could also be essential for formulation of new schemes, especially in Social Sector Schemes.

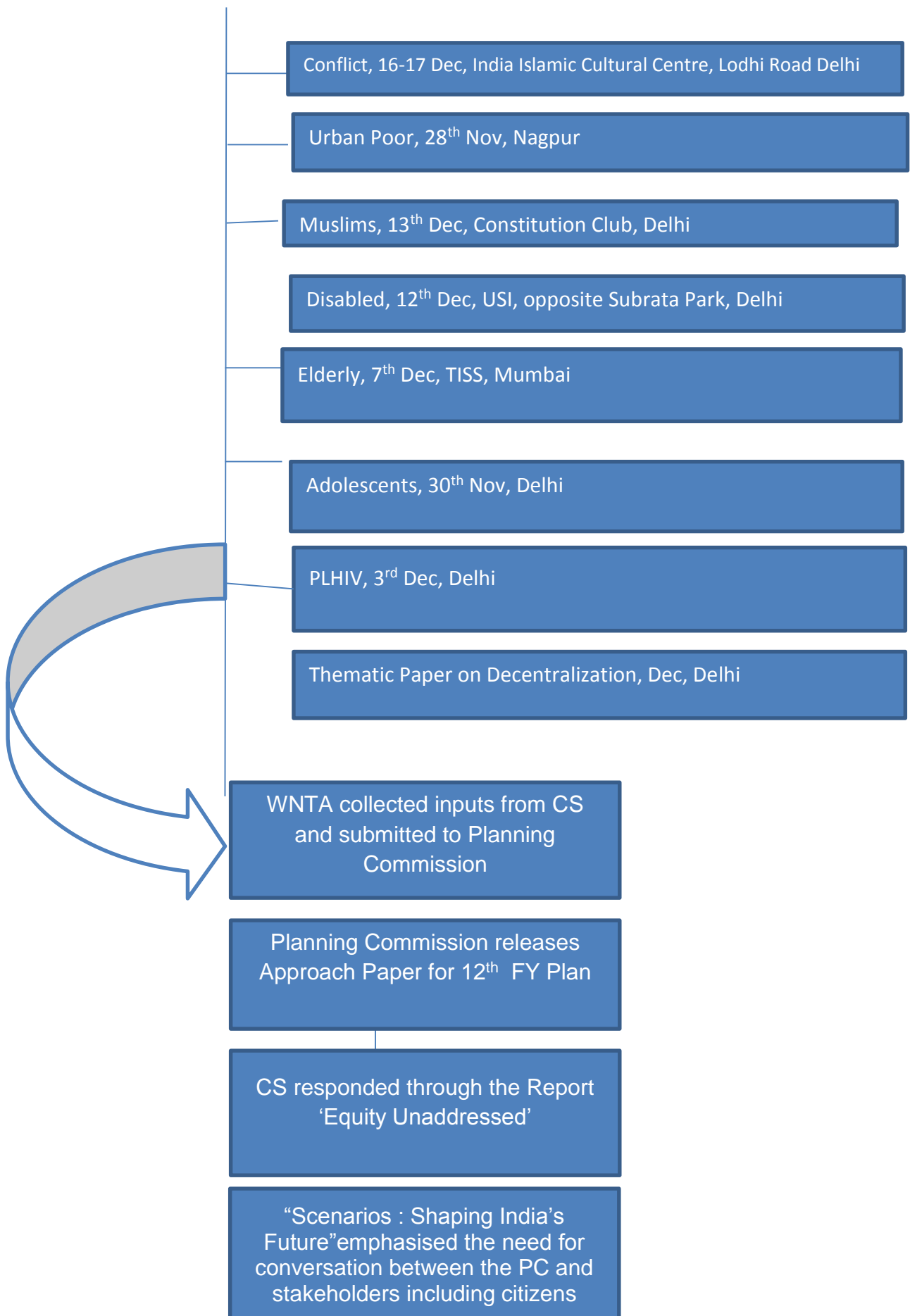
