G S.R— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Planning Commission (Joint Adviser) Recruitment Rules, 2012 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Joint Adviser in the NITI Aayog, namely:-

**1. Short title and commencement –**

- (1) These rules may be called the NITI Aayog, Joint Adviser Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2017.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay –**

The number of the said posts, their classification and the level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

**3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc –**

The method of recruitment relating to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

**4. Disqualification -**

No person, -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person

from the operation of these rules.

**5. Power to relax –**

Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**6. Tenure for Deputation (including short-term contract)/ Direct Recruitment on contract basis –**

5 years and extendable upto 7 years

**7. Saving –**

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of the age limit and other concessions required to be provided for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with other orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

**I. For Deputation (including short-term contract)/ Promotion:**

Officers of the Central/ State Governments/Union Territories/ Universities/Recognised Research Institutions/Public Sector Undertakings/ Autonomous Organisations:-

(a) (i) Holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; **or**

(ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in posts in **Level 12 in the Pay Matrix** in the parent cadre or department; and

(b) possessing the educational and other qualifications as prescribed for direct recruitment in column (7).

**Note I:** The Departmental Deputy Adviser of the NITI Aayog in **Level 12 in the Pay Matrix** with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis and possessing the educational qualifications as prescribed in the Annexure to these Rules will also be considered along with outsiders. If a Departmental Deputy Adviser is selected for appointment to the post, it will be treated as having filled by Promotion.

**Note II:** A department officer on being selected for appointment on promotion will be required to successfully complete in-house training of one week.

**Note III:** For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1-1-2016/the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Seventh Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding Pay Matrix extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission.

**Note IV:** The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation/absorption. Similarly, the deputationists candidates shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by Promotion.

**Note V:** For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1-1-2016/the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Seventh Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding Pay Matrix extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised Pay Band/Grade Pay into one common Level in the Pay Matrix, and where this benefit will extend on for the post (s) for which that Level in the Pay Matrix is the normal replacement Level without any upgradation.

**Note VI:** Period of deputation (ISTC) including period of deputation (ISTC) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisations/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed five years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (ISTC) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date for receipt of applications.

Minimum 10 years' experience (which shall include upto 3 years for Ph.D. provided no work experience is counted during those 3 years)) in formulation, appraisal, execution/ implementation, research, monitoring and evaluation of policy, programme or projects.

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AGREEMENT

ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT made this day of Two Thousand and Seventeen BETWEEN .....son of Shri. ....at present residing at ..  
..... Here in after referred to as party of the first part and the PRESIDENT OF INDIA (HEREINAFTER CALLED "THE Government") of the second part.

WHEREAS it has been agreed between the parties that the party of the first part shall be appointed as the..... in the ..... with effect from the afternoon of ..... For a period of..... years or until further orders on contract basis on the terms and conditions herein contained.

NOW THESE PRESENTS WITNESSETH AND THE PARTIES HERETO RESPECTIVELY AGREE AS FOLLOWS;

1. The Government has agreed to engage the party of the first part and the party of the first part has agreed to serve the Government as .....in the With effect from the forenoon/afternoon of ..... of a period of..... years or until further orders on contract basis on the terms and conditions herein contained. The party of the first part shall submit himself to the orders of the Government and of the officers and authorities under whom he may from time to time be placed by the Government and shall remain in the service subject to the provisions herein contained.

2. The party of the first part shall devote his whole time to his duties and shall, whenever required, proceed to any part in or outside India and perform such duties as may be assigned to him by the Government.

3. The appointment of the party of the first part as .....in the ..... Shall continue for a period of ..... years or until further orders of the, Government, subject to the provisions contained in the following clause 4.

4. The service of the party of the first part may be terminated by giving one calendar month notice in writing any time during the terms of the appointment under this agreement either by the party of the first part to the Government or by the Government or its authorized officer to the party of the first part without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

5. Remuneration : The party of the first may opt to choose pay as per Govt Salary or consolidated pay as per following terms and conditions :

5.(a) Pay and Allowances as per Central Govt :

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- i. The party of the first shall, from the forenoon/ afternoon..... receive a pay of Rs..... (Rupees only) in Pay Matrix .....minus pension and ad-hoc relief grants, if any, paid or payable by the Central or State Government to the party of the first part subject to the condition that the pay plus pension should not exceed Rs..... S/he shall be entitled for annual increment as per stages in the pay matrix subject to satisfactory performance. S/He shall, in addition, be entitled to receive such compensatory and other allowances as may be prescribed by the Government for the class of officers serving in the equivalent post to which Government has declared the party of the first part to correspond in status or conditions of service. The aforesaid pay and allowances shall be paid to the party of the first part for such time as he shall serve under this agreement and actually perform his duties commencing from the aforesaid date and ceasing on the date of his quitting service or on the date of his discharge there from or on the expiration of his terms of service under this agreement or on the day of his death if he shall die whilst in service. If at any time the party of the first part proceeds on deputation out of India his pay during the period of his deputation shall be regulated by the Central Government rules and orders regarding deputation.
- ii. In case the party of the first part opts to occupy government residential accommodation, he will be eligible for the type and category of accommodation on the same terms as for the class of officers serving in equivalent post, which the Government has declared the party of the first part to correspond in status or conditions of service. This would need concurrence of Ministry of Urban Development. In case the party of the first part resides in his own accommodation, he will be entitled to the House Rent Allowance as admissible.
- iii. The party of the first part will be entitled for leave/ encashment of leave in terms of DOPT's OM No. 12016/3/84-Estt. (L) dated 12th April 1985 as amended by OM No. 12016/1/90-Estt. (L) dated 5th July 1990, OM No. 12016/2/90-Estt. (L) dated 12th July 1999 and OM No 12016/5/2009- Estt.{L} dated 31st January 011.
- iv. The party of the first part will be entitled to travelling allowance and other allowances, as admissible to equivalent class of officers in the Government of India on transfer, for the journey of the party of the first part and his family members for taking over his assignment at the headquarters. The party of the first part will be allowed the same facilities, to settle anywhere in India, on his relinquishing the charge.
- v. The party of the first part shall be eligible for all concessions in relation to medical attendance and treatment that may be prescribed by Government for the class of officers serving in the equivalent post to which the Government may declare the. party of the first part to correspond in status or in conditions

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of service, subject to the payment by him of contribution as applicable, under the prescribed rules.

- vi. During his service under these presents, the party of the first part shall be entitled to Leave Travel Concession as admissible under the rules and orders of the Government from time to time in force.
- vii. Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained the pay and leave salary admissible under these presents whether payable in India or elsewhere shall be subject to any emergency cut that may be ordered by the Government for the same period and on the same terms as for other officers of the equivalent post and status under the administrative control of the Government.

### 5 (b) Consolidated pay –

- i. The party of the first part shall, from the forenoon/ afternoon..... receive a consolidated pay of Rs..... (Rupees only).
- ii. Consolidated pay package will be raised by 25 percent as and when Dearness Allowance goes up by 50 percent.
- iii. The party of the first part shall not be entitled for Govt accommodation, HRA, staff car, travelling allowances, medical facility, leave encashment, LTC or any other benefits and allowances as admissible to the party opted for Pay and Allowances as per Central Govt as mentioned at clause 5(a).

6. If the party of the first part is required to travel in the interest of the public service, he shall be entitled to traveling allowance on the scale provided for in the rules supplementary to the Fundamental rules framed by the Government from time to time in force and applicable to the officers of his class.

7. The party of the first part will not be allowed to join any retirement scheme of the Government of India.

8. In respect of any matter relating to the conduct, discipline and other conditions of service and in respect of which no provisions has been made in this agreement, the provisions of the C.C.S. (Conduct) Rules, 1964 and C.C.S. (C.C.A.) Rules 1965, or any other rules made or deemed to be made under article 309 or contained under article 313 of the constitution shall apply to the party of the first part to the extent to which they are applicable to the service hereby provided for and the decision of the Government as to their applicability shall be final.

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9. The stamp duty payable on this agreement shall be borne by the Government.
